The Cibolo Creek Municipal Authority (“CCMA”) is requesting sealed bids (“Invitation for Bids”) from qualified, responsible Bidders to provide responsive bids for the rehabilitation of a lift station and all necessary appurtenances and installation of approximately 12,500 linear feet of force main located in the area of Cibolo, Texas known as the **TOWN CREEK LIFT STATION AND FORCE MAIN** (“Project”). All qualified firms including Small, Minority, and Women Owned Businesses are encouraged to submit bids in response to this bid invitation.

Bidders must submit sealed Bids **by no later than 10:00 AM CST, on Thursday, June 29, 2017 at the Cibolo Creek Municipal Authority, 100 Dietz Road, Schertz, TX, 78154.** CCMA will open the Sealed Bids in the CCMA offices located at the above address at 10:00 AM CST, on Thursday, June 29, 2017. Bids must be sealed and clearly marked: **“TOWN CREEK LIFT STATION AND FORCE MAIN”**, Solicitation # CCMA-2017-001 and bear the name and address of the Bidder.

A Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 2:00 pm local time on June 8, 2017 at Cibolo Creek Municipal Authority Treatment Plant, 12423 Authority Lane, Schertz, TX, 78154. Representatives of CCMA and its Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Bidders must attend and participate in the Pre-Bid Conference in order for their Bid to qualify for consideration for award. Engineer will transmit to all Bidders who attend the Pre-Bid Conference, such Addenda as Engineer considers necessary to respond to questions which arise during the Pre-Bid Conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

If a contract is awarded, CCMA will award the contract to the Bidder whose Bid represents the technically acceptable Bid with the lowest price based on the evaluation described in the Bid documents.

Equal Opportunity in Employment by Bidders.
